

Dr GIORGIO LORENZON

Born in Turin on May 26th, 1947, he graduated in Surgery and Medicine in 1973.

He specialized in Cardiology in 1976, in Cardiovascular surgery in 1979 and in Odontostomatology in 1982. He was internship student from 1967 to 1969 at the Cardiac surgery center at the University of Turin. He collaborated with Dr Angelo Actis Dato for diagnosis and operating activity.

Since 1974, ER assistant and supervisor of the Cardiac Surgery and Hemodynamic Department at the Chivasso Hospital. From 1976 to 1979, assistant at the Coronary and Cardiology Department at the University of Turin. Since 1979, he practises full-time Dentistry, managing the Surgical Center of Brandizzo.

He has been lecturer at many conventions of Cardiology, Cardiac Surgery and Experimental Surgery. Author of many publications in these specialties, he is co-author of the essay "Annuloplasty ring mitral valve" and "Pectus Excavatum Surgical Therapy".

In the dental field, he took part as lecturer at conferences in Italy and abroad. He was guest as Visiting Professor at the Burdenko Hospital of Moscow and at the University of Bucharest.

He published works in Italian and foreign journals both in medical and bioengineering field.

He has been collaborating for many years with the *Politecnico di Torino* at the Mechanics Department (Biomechanics course) and at the Materials Science and Clinical Engineering Department.
